

OG Bagger HoneyComp Brake Pedal Gripper Kit Installation

- 1. Before you start your new kit installation, you will need to remove your stock Bagger brake pedal cover.
- 2. Put your new OG HoneyComp gripper on top of your stock, now naked, foot brake arm. Using a small marker, mark the 4 mounting holes where your new gripper plate covers the entire brake arm surface area. Once done, put aside your OG Brake Pedal Gripper.
- Apply the included drill pattern sticker on top of the 4 holes mark making it as straight as possible
 with the brake arm edges. The tapered sticker edge should face the outside of the bike. Refer to
 picture below.



- 4. Drill all 4 passing holes using a 7/32" bit. We recommend using a center punch and smaller drill bits in the process for a better result. Apply a good amount of grease in all 4 holes to prevent corrosion.
 - Note. For a cleaner look you can shave down your OEM pedal arm in order for it to match your new gripper mounting surface. Just use the same drill pattern sticker as a reference. If you end up doing it, we recommend having the brake arm painted/powder coated before reinstallation.
- 5. Mount your new gripper plate using the supplied hardware. Lock it down tight by hand, no need for threadlocker here; we supplied locknuts
- 6. Enjoy!

Note: You can always go back to your stock brake pedal cover since it will hide the 4 holes drilled. No need to buy another kit when changing for a new bike. Just swap it back!
