

OG Highway Peg Crash Bar for Harley-Davidson M8 Softail Installation

- 1. Before you start your new crash bar installation, you will need to remove your stock Softail peg mounts & rear brake assembly from the frame. Please refer to service manual if needed. You can put away your stock hardware, you will not need it for the installation.
- 2. Slide in the crashbar onto the frame and align it so you can put 2x bolts on each side so it hold onto the bike. Assemble the Throttle side / Right side and mount all 4x propper bolts as per picture below. Do not torque them yet.




Figure 1 - FOR MID CONTROLS




Figure 2 - FOR FORWARD CONTROLS

3. Assemble the Clutch side / Left side and mount all 4x propper bolts as per picture below. Do not torque them yet.






Figure 3 - FOR MID CONTROLS




Figure 4 - FOR FORWARD CONTROLS

- 4. Torque all bolts. Recommended Torque 25 ft-lbs, no need for threadlocker here; we recommend using some anti-seeze on all bolts.
- 5. Assemble both billet tips using supplied 3/8-16 x 1" screws. Recommended Torque 15 ft-lbs.

Note: Replacement billet tips part number: C-AC-01.
